TRAILS

- We spent ~\$800 to hire Ian McKinnon with his small backhoe to regrade the beginning of the Viewpoint Trail, and to repair trail erosion and bridge washout in the lower section of No Brakes trail.
- In the spring a slide occurred on the Kaslo River Trail South due to snow melt being channeled along Arena Ave then downslope to the Kaslo River. The bank debris flow covered the trail and a work party was able to dig through the debris to re-establish the trail. Water flow continues to be an issue this current spring.
- We worked on the Mount Buchanan viewpoint trail and the Wagon Road trail as per our agreements with BC Rec and Trails and the Rails to Trails Society.
- Work parties focused on re-routing steep sections of the trails above the Wardner Trail Viewpoint, placing concrete benches for fundraising, trail work around wet areas on the Lettrari Loop, putting in some chain link fencing along the Lakeside Trail for separation of the trail from the Kaslo Boat Charters workshop area, brushing and trail establishment around the old Pelton Wheel on the Kaslo River Trail North.
- As always, please let us know what you see on the trails that needs to be attended to.

VOLUNTEER REPORT

- Specific to Trails (not including fundraising, Nordic, KAMBI, etc), in 2017 we had ~20 volunteers work a total of 162 hours.
- Total # of volunteer hours = 9191 since inception in 2005
